

**IMMANUEL VESTRY MEETING**

**KEY MESSAGES**

- Vestry unanimously approved the nominating committee's recommendation and appointed Emilie Jewett-Curley as a Vestry member. Emilie was appointed under the authority of the diocesan Canon and Regulations effective immediately, to serve a term ending at Immanuel's next Annual General Meeting. Congratulations, and welcome Emilie.
- Vestry voted unanimously to support the Diocesan Care Home Services ministry beginning on September 22, 2022. Rev Winna Martin is leading and coordinating this ministry. Deacon Susan Page is providing leadership for some care home services that Immanuel will be leading. All parishioners are encouraged to participate in this ministry as they are able. Rev Diane was given a warm welcome at the "Welcome Back to Church" lunch on September 11.
