# **KEY MESSAGES FROM DECEMBER 14, 2022, VESTRY MEETING**

#### 1. Immanuel's Christmas Service times:

# 2. Highlights of the Clergy Report include:

- On December 11 the **Sunday School led worship**. It was a huge success. There were 122 people at worship that Sunday.
- We have returned to the practice of having the offering plate passed to people in the pews.
- There will now be **three communion stations** one in the centre, one by the choir, and one by the font.
- We will have **Morning Prayer** when there is a fifth Sunday in a month, plus 4-5 times on other Sundays throughout the year.
- We will begin putting worship leaders and Communion Assistants on a schedule for Sundays.

### 3. Highlights from the Transition Team Report include:

- The **Transition Team** met on November 29 for a 2022 Wrap-up and "Thanks".
- The following strengths for Immanuel were identified and celebrated: Mercy,
  Generosity, Service, and Faith. These were all rated very high compared to the other
  eight gifts identified. There was a concern that no one had identified Evangelism as a
  strength. This is an important aspect of our church life. Further research will be done on
  some subtle strategies that Immanuel members could be encouraged to use in sharing
  their faith.
- The Team discussed "Examining Ministry and Outreach Projects Growing our Branches" that will be the topic after church at a Special Congregational Meeting scheduled for January 29, 2023, after worship. The focus of the meeting will be about "Going Forward". Watch for more details to come.

**4.** Immanuel's **Annual General Meeting** will be **February 26, 2023,** after the worship service. More details to come.

# 5. Immanuel's 2023 and Beyond Capital Plan

• There was discussion on updating the **Capital Plan** that was taken to the parishioners at the February 2022 AGM. The plan will be expanded to a three-year capital plan.

# 6. Financial Report

- The November parishioner contributions were \$22,860, the highest in the year.
- There was a surplus income of \$7,708 in November.
- December is typically the highest month for donations from parishioners.
- Reference was made to appreciating the possibility of allocating funds to be set aside for priorities and what is important to Immanuel in the future, e.g., Youth Ministry CLAY.
- It is good for a potential incumbent to look at our parish and see there are funds and opportunity dollars there and available for those kinds of activities.
